### TUITION POLICY

- MCS offers a tuition payment plan of twelve (12) equal monthly installments. The first of twelve (12) monthly installments is due July 3, 2017. If the first payment is not received by July 3, 2017, we will assume the student is not returning, and your enrollment fee and class position will be forfeited.
- All accounts must be kept current in order for students to continue their education at Macomb Christian Schools. Children of families whose accounts fall over thirty (30) days behind may be prevented from attending school.

### TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance is available to qualifying families. Multiple child discounts do **not** apply when tuition assistance is given. The tuition assistance is processed through the FACTS tuition assistance service. There is a \$30 processing fee. Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3YF66> to apply for tuition assistance.

## Fees

<b>Enrollment Fee</b> Enrollment fees are non-refundable. No portion of the fee will be applied to tuition. The enrollment process must be completed along with the receipt of the enrollment fee before a student is officially considered for enrollment.	<b>\$100 per student or \$200 per family (if received <u>by</u> February 28)  \$200 per student or \$400 per family (if received <u>after</u> February 28)</b>
<b>Technology Fee</b> Fee covers tech advancements and Accelerated Reader.	<b>\$10.00 per student (annual fee)</b>
<b>Student Planner (Grades 2-6)</b>	<b>\$5.00</b>
<b>Fee for Unserved Volunteer Hours</b>	<b>Each family is required to work 20 hours each school year, or pay an additional fee. Five of the 20 hours must be served in the re-sale shop. Hours not worked will be billed at the rate of \$20 per hour.</b>
<b>Sports Participation Fees</b> No student will be assessed more than \$190 per year in sports fees. All fees are non-refundable and must be paid prior to the first game of each sport. High school golf also has a \$25 per student fee for greens in addition to the Sports Fee (not included in the \$190 per student/per year max)	<b>Grades 1-5, \$60 per student, per sport  Grades 6-12, \$95 per student, per sport</b>
<b>Latchkey Fees</b> Latchkey is provided before and after school for students Kindergarten through 15 years old. Students who require before or after school care must complete registration forms before attending. Students not picked up by 3:30pm will be sent to Latchkey. Latchkey is open until 6:00pm.	<b>\$4.00 per hour (billed by 15 min. increments) Late fee applies after 6 pm - \$10 for first 15 minutes, \$1.00 per minute thereafter  \$35 Registration Fee (Elementary grades only)</b>
<b>Detention Fees</b> All students who receive a detention will be charged an hourly rate.	<b>\$4.00 per hour</b>
